

For professional disciplines - architectural history, historic architecture, historians (historic research), and architectural history, there are National Park Service (NPS) Professional Qualification Standards as part of the larger Secretary of the Interior's Standards and Guidelines for Archaeology and Historic Preservation (36CFR Part 61, Appendix A). The Professional Qualifications Standards represent only a minimum threshold for training and professional experience that practitioners should demonstrate to be considered specialists in their field(s).


