TO THE BUILDING NEEDS COMMITTEE:

Ron Picherri, Norman Clemence and Ruth Hopfmann from this committee met with the Selectmen on this date at 7 p.m. to discuss the future of our committee. The selectmen acknowledged receipt of our report of Nov. 29, 1995 summarizing the activities and meetings which we held from Jan. 1994 thru May, 1995.

Since only three members were present the discussion was short, but they stated that they wished us to continue looking into the other building needs of the town - especially a use for the Town Hall which they did not want to remain empty after the town offices were moved to the Butterick building. It was also agreed that we should investigate land parcels which could be used for siting a new police station. Suggested were: Butterick School land, Jeff/land between the old cemetery and Bird Street. Also they seemed to be in favor of using the town hall for the station, even leaving the second floor as is for the time being.
